Yolo County Fair Olive Oil Contest Rules

The Yolo County Fair Olive Oil Competition will be professionally judged and extensively publicized.

RULES:

1. The Yolo County Fair Olive Oil Competition is limited to all Extra Virgin and flavored Olive Oils produced in California.
2. An entry consists of (2) two bottles of at least (7) seven ounces in size which becomes the sole property of Yolo County Fair.
3. Entry fee, to be submitted with entry form is \$50 per Olive Oil entry.
4. All entries must be available for sale to the general public at full price. All bottles must be labeled and ready for Market and not be open.
5. Organic Producers must submit California Organic Registration or Certification Number.
6. Producer must indicate level of intensity on entry form.
7. Experimental lots are not permitted.
8. Entrants must fill in required information on entry sheet fully.
9. All Flavored Oils must meet the established standards set by the State of California Regulations Title 17, Section 12400.
10. All entries must be received by 5 PM, March 14, 2007. Entries may be sent via mail or UPS or delivered directly. Entry fees must accompany samples, and will not be refunded.

JUDGING:

1. Judging will be held April 3, 2007.
2. Official judging panel will consist of professional panel assembled by Paul Vossen, University of California resident Olive Oil expert.
3. The International Olive Oil Council (IOOC) Mario Solinas Competition Score Sheet will be used for judging.
4. Judges have the ability to change Class, Section, or Intensity during event.

AWARDS:

1. Gold, Silver and Bronze awards will be determined by the judges in all classes.
2. Fifty 2007 Yolo County Fair Seals will be given to Gold and Silver Award Winners.
3. Best of Show will be selected from among the Best of Class winners.
4. There will be one each Best of Show Oils – Conventional and Organic.
5. There will be one each of Best Flavored Oils – Conventional and Organic.
6. There will be a special award for Best of Yolo County to be decided among the judges.
7. Winner will be notified electronically or by mail within 14 days of competition.

POST JUDGING:

1. During the 2007 Yolo County Fair, all winners will be recognized.
2. Press releases regarding winners of the 2007 judging will be sent to all major publications and media outlets.
